What competencies are we looking for on the internship programme?

We are looking for people who can demonstrate a good working knowledge of one or more of the following technologies:

- Java and J2EE
- PHP
- Drupal
- Web Services (REST and SOAP)
- Database Technologies (POSTGRES, MYSQL)

Candidates should be able to demonstrate:

- Strong interpersonal skills, including an ability to communicate in a technical and non-technical environment
- Ability to work in small teams as well as to use initiative when required
- Proactive in tackling new challenges and learning new technologies to solve problems
- Effective analysis, design and documenting skills

To qualify, applicants should either be completing their second or final year of a first degree, undertaking postgraduate studies in a relevant discipline, or be a recent graduate. Applications, in the form of a CV with a covering letter, should be made to careers@aber.ac.uk Current students will be subject to referral to the applicant's academic department prior to shortlisting.

Shortlisted candidates will be interviewed on 20th June at Aberystwyth. Skype conferencing will be considered as an option for candidates no longer based in Aberystwyth. The Internship Programme will start at the end of June with a maximum duration of three months.

Interns who perform exceptionally well on the programme will be offered permanent positions within the company.
